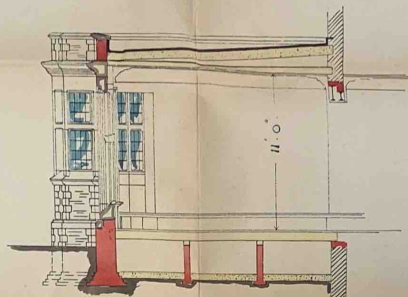

Their attention is particularly directed to BYE-LAWS 97 to 105, as to the giving of Notices.

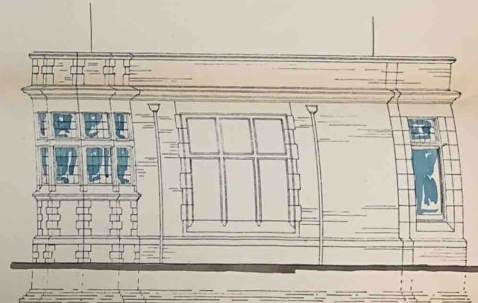
# ADDITION TO LIBRARY, BERRY HALL, SOLIHULL.



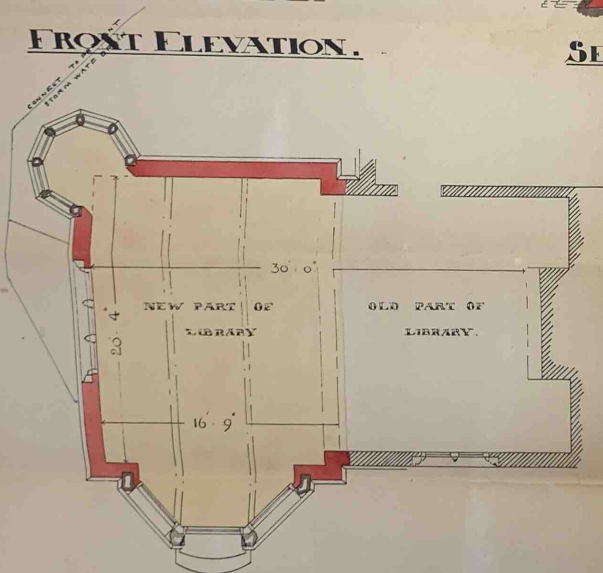
**FRONT ELEVATION.**



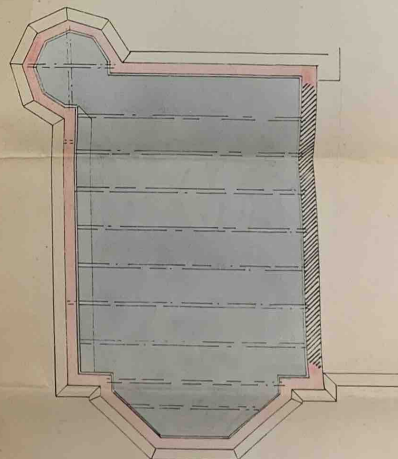
**SECTION ON LINE AB.**
